Human Rights Defenders Coalition (HRDC) says t will on May 28 hold a fresh wave of nationwide demonstrations to force out embattled Malawi Electoral Commission (MEC) chairperson Jane Ansah and her team for alleged incompetence.

Briefing journalists in Lilongwe yesterday, HRDC national chairperson Gift Trapence said the impunity demonstrated by MEC commissioners has prompted the coalition to revive the demonstrations.

He said: "We have announced demos on 28th of May. We want Jane Ansah and her fellow ommissioners to leave MEC.


