
1. Mobile Malware Scam Arrests


In early 2025, Zambian authorities arrested 14 individuals linked to a criminal syndicate that disseminated malware through malicious links sent via messaging apps. Once a victim clicked the link, the malware compromised their device, granting hackers access to banking applications and enabling the spread of the malicious link to the victim's contacts, thereby amplifying the scam's reach. 
